Privacy Policy

Waitlist and Pre-Launch Early Access Program

Last updated: 16 June 2026

Scope of this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy applies only to the TerriFiX Point Ltd. landing page, waitlist, pre-launch communications, optional feedback, founder questions, and early access benefit. It is not the full privacy policy for the future TerriFiX Point Ltd. wallet, payment, currency conversion, or AI financial expert services. Those future services may involve additional data processing and will be subject to separate or updated privacy notices, product terms, eligibility checks, regulatory requirements, and local availability when launched.

1. Who We Are

TerriFiX Point Ltd. is an Israeli company incorporated under the laws of the State of Israel, company registration number 517042982 ("TerriFiX", "we", "us", or "our").

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, TerriFiX is responsible for the personal information collected through the TerriFiX landing page and waitlist.

2. What Information We Collect at the Waitlist Stage

At the current waitlist and pre-launch stage, TerriFiX collects only limited information, such as:

- your email address;
- your country or country of residence;
- your consent choices, including whether you agreed to receive emails from TerriFiX;
- your waitlist registration date, technical records, and related metadata;
- optional feedback, questions, ideas, or comments you choose to submit;
- basic website and landing page usage information, such as device, browser, referral source, pages viewed, approximate location derived from IP address, and similar analytics information.

At this stage, TerriFiX does not ask for your name, payment card details, bank account details, wallet details, tax ID, government ID, credit history, transaction history, investment information, or access credentials. TerriFiX does not connect to bank accounts, card accounts, payment accounts, or any private financial databases at this stage.

3. How We Use Your Information

TerriFiX uses personal information collected at the waitlist stage to:

- register you for the TerriFiX waitlist;
- confirm your waitlist status and early access eligibility;
- send product updates, launch updates, early access invitations, country availability notices, and related TerriFiX announcements where you have consented or where otherwise permitted by law;

- respond to questions, founder questions, and optional feedback;
- evaluate demand, improve TerriFiX's landing page, communications, and product plans;
- prevent duplicate, false, automated, abusive, or fraudulent registrations;
- maintain security, debug issues, and operate the landing page;
- comply with legal, regulatory, accounting, security, and recordkeeping requirements.

TerriFiX does not use waitlist information to make regulated credit, investment, payment, wallet, or eligibility decisions at this stage.

4. Legal Bases for Processing

Depending on where you are located, TerriFiX may rely on one or more legal bases to process your personal information, including:

- your consent, for example when you join the waitlist or opt in to receive product updates;
- TerriFiX's legitimate interests, such as operating a pre-launch waitlist, improving the product, preventing abuse, and securing the landing page;
- steps taken at your request before entering into a future product relationship, such as recording your interest in early access;
- compliance with legal obligations where applicable.

Where TerriFiX relies on consent, you may withdraw that consent at any time by unsubscribing from emails or contacting us at admin@terrifix.net. Withdrawal of consent does not affect processing that took place before withdrawal.

5. Emails and Marketing Communications

If you consent to receive emails from TerriFiX, we may send you emails about your waitlist status, product updates, early access invitations, availability in your country, and related TerriFiX announcements.

You can unsubscribe from marketing or product update emails at any time by using the unsubscribe link in our emails or contacting us at admin@terrifix.net.

Even if you unsubscribe from marketing emails, TerriFiX may still send administrative or legal emails where necessary, such as changes to this Privacy Policy, changes to the Terms & Conditions, or notices related to your waitlist registration.

6. Optional Feedback and Founder Questions

After joining the waitlist, you may choose to answer optional questions, provide feedback, or ask questions to TerriFiX's founders. This is voluntary.

TerriFiX may use feedback, suggestions, questions, ideas, or comments to evaluate, improve, develop, market, and operate TerriFiX products and services. If your feedback includes personal information, TerriFiX will handle that personal information according to this Privacy Policy.

Please do not submit sensitive personal information, bank account information, card details, government identification numbers, passwords, or confidential third-party information through waitlist feedback or founder questions.

7. Cookies, Analytics, and Similar Technologies

TerriFiX may use cookies, pixels, analytics tools, log files, and similar technologies to operate the landing page, understand how visitors use it, measure demand, improve performance, prevent abuse, and support product development.

These tools may collect information such as IP address, approximate location, browser type, device information, referral source, pages viewed, and interaction events. Where required by law, TerriFiX will request consent before using non-essential cookies or similar technologies.

TerriFiX does not use cookies at the waitlist stage to access your bank account, card account, payment account, or private financial information.

8. Sharing Personal Information

TerriFiX may share personal information with limited third parties where necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, such as:

- website hosting and cloud infrastructure providers;
- email delivery and waitlist management providers;
- analytics, security, debugging, and anti-abuse service providers;
- professional advisers, such as lawyers, accountants, and auditors;
- regulators, courts, law enforcement, or public authorities where required by law;
- potential investors, acquirers, or transaction parties in connection with a financing, merger, acquisition, restructuring, or similar corporate transaction, subject to appropriate confidentiality protections.

TerriFiX does not sell or trade users' personal data. TerriFiX will not push services users do not need or make recommendations based on undisclosed commercial incentives.

9. International Transfers

TerriFiX is incorporated in Israel and may use service providers located in Israel, the European Economic Area, the United States, the United Kingdom, or other countries.

Where personal information is transferred internationally, TerriFiX will take steps intended to protect it in accordance with applicable law, which may include contractual safeguards, security measures, and other legally recognized transfer mechanisms where required.

10. Data Retention

TerriFiX keeps waitlist information only for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, including maintaining the waitlist, managing early access eligibility, sending updates where permitted, preventing abuse, complying with legal obligations, and maintaining business records.

If you unsubscribe or ask us to delete your waitlist information, TerriFiX will delete or anonymize your personal information where required by law, unless TerriFiX needs to retain limited information for legal, security, anti-abuse, recordkeeping, or administrative purposes.

11. Security

TerriFiX uses reasonable technical and organizational measures designed to protect personal information against unauthorized access, loss, misuse, alteration, or disclosure.

No website, email system, database, or internet transmission is completely secure. You should not send sensitive financial information, passwords, card details, bank account details, or government identification numbers through the landing page, waitlist form, email, or optional feedback fields unless TerriFiX expressly provides a secure method for that purpose.

12. Your Rights and Choices

Depending on where you are located and subject to applicable law, you may have rights to:

- request access to personal information TerriFiX holds about you;
- request correction of inaccurate information;
- request deletion of your information;
- object to or restrict certain processing;
- withdraw consent where processing is based on consent;
- request a copy of your information in a portable format where applicable;
- unsubscribe from marketing or product update emails;
- lodge a complaint with a competent data protection authority.

To exercise rights or ask privacy questions, contact TerriFiX at admin@terrifix.net. TerriFiX may need to verify your identity before responding to certain requests.

13. Children

The TerriFiX waitlist and early access program are not intended for children. You must be at least 18 years old, or the age of legal majority in your country, to join the waitlist or participate in the early access program.

TerriFiX does not knowingly collect personal information from children at the waitlist stage. If TerriFiX learns that a child has submitted personal information, TerriFiX may delete it.

14. Future Product Services

The TerriFiX wallet, payment, currency conversion, and AI financial expert services are not fully launched at the time this Privacy Policy is published. When those services become available, they may involve additional categories of personal information, such as identity verification information, transaction information, wallet information, payment information, financial behavior information, device security information, AI interaction data, and other product-specific information.

Any future regulated or product-specific services will be subject to separate or updated privacy notices, product terms, risk disclosures, fee disclosures, country-specific terms, regulatory requirements, and eligibility checks.

TerriFiX will not connect to bank accounts, card accounts, payment accounts, wallets, or private financial databases unless a future product clearly explains the connection and you provide the required authorization.

15. No Sale of Personal Data and No Hidden Incentive Model

TerriFiX will not sell or trade users' personal data.

TerriFiX's intended model is to keep the service aligned with users and not to profit from hidden costs, poor financial decisions, or undisclosed commercial incentives. If TerriFiX introduces third-party partnerships, optional services, or commercial arrangements that are relevant to users, TerriFiX will provide disclosures as required by applicable law and product terms.

16. Changes to this Privacy Policy

TerriFiX may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. If we make material changes, we may notify waitlist users by email or by posting an updated version on the TerriFiX website.

The updated Privacy Policy will apply from the date stated in the updated version, subject to applicable law.
